With a vast assortment of organic produce, herbs, pickles, jams, deli-treats and home-grown goods, this vibrant market with marimba music adding to the relaxed rural atmosphere, has become one of the most popular weekly market venues in the country.

• Also on Saturdays, come rain or shine, the Food and Wine Market at the state-of-the-art Hermanuspietersfontein Wine Cellar, which can be found in the Hemel-en-Aarde Village, offers free wine tasting and unique gourmet-style food stalls in a lively, elegant atmosphere. Visit their market courtyard from 09:00 to 13:00.

• The charming Onrus Craft Market runs on the first Saturday morning of each month at the De Wet Hall in Roos Street. With its fun, eclectic mix of old-school stalls and activities it's a great way to fill up on bargains and catch up with the locals.

• For something different, be sure to stop for a hot cup of tea or coffee and fresh scones at the St Peter's Church Coffee Morning every Saturday from 09:30. This tranquil garden setting in Main Road Hermanus, is the perfect escape from the hustle and bustle of a busy Saturday in the CBD.
