Whale Festival

The Whale Festival is held to celebrate the arrival of the magnificent Southern Right Whales that come to Walker Bay to calve and mate.

The festival offers a variety of eco-environmental activities; a children's festival; an arts ramble that takes visitors to the studios and galleries of local artists and other live entertainment.

There is also plenty of action for the health-conscious with several sporting events, namely a half-marathon, fun cycle ride, soccer and golf day.
